EACH PLAYER TO COMPLETE A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM

Junior (U16)

1. All competitors must reside or attend a school or club within the Boroughs of Crewe and Nantwich, Congleton or Vale Royal or be registered as an affiliated member to either the junior league or a junior club playing in the said league.

NO CURRENT BADMINTON ENGLAND GRADE 1(GOLD), 2(SILVER) OR 3(BRONZE) PLAYERS ARE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THEIR RESPECTIVE AGE GROUP CATEGORY. THEY ARE, HOWEVER, ELIGIBLE TO ENTER HIGHER AGE GROUP CATEGORIES.

2. Entries will not be accepted unless sent to the Tournament Secretary, accompanied by the correct entry form and fee.
3. Entries accompanied by payment must be sent to the Tournament Secretary to arrive no later than the Closing Date. All cheques or postal orders should be made payable to Crewe and District Badminton League. Please include a S.A.E if an acknowledgement is required.

Under no circumstances will late entries be accepted.

4. Player requiring a partner should indicate this on their entry forms, and every effort will be made to obtain one for them. Partners will be allocated in strict order of receipt of entry form.

If, due to unforeseen circumstances, a player, having already entered, has to withdraw, substitutes will be accepted provided the Tournament Secretary is notified at least 1 week prior to the event taking place.

No substitutes will be allowed in the preceding week prior to the event.

5. Players **must** wear acceptable Badminton Sports clothing.
(BAoE - Tournament Regulation Rule 28)
6. **All successful competitors must be prepared to play for the duration of the Whole Tournament.**
7. Knocking up times will be limited to 2 minutes.
8. Players must report to the Referee on arrival. Players not ready to play when called to do so render themselves liable to be scratched. Players may not leave the hall without the referee's permission.
9. Challenge Trophies will be played for annually. The holders will be responsible for the safe keeping and professional engraving by the Leagues nominated engraver, the cost of which will be borne by the League.
10. Trophies must be returned in a presentable state **no later than one month prior** to the following year's tournament
11. The Tournament Organising Committee reserve the right to alter the programme of the Tournament at its discretion and to cancel any event should there be insufficient entries
12. The Tournament Referee's decision shall be final.
